

## **NON-SUFFICIENT FUNDS: A VIOLATION OF THE MLCC ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

Licensees, please note that when you write a non-sufficient funds check for a purchase of alcoholic liquor from the State of Michigan it is considered a violation of the Michigan Liquor Code (R 436.1059 of the Michigan Administrative Code). In addition to paying the amount of the check and the processing fee, a separate violation is written and can result in a fine of up to \$300 or a license suspension, revocation or placement on a cash-only payment basis for an extended period of time.

Protect your license and keep it violation free – do not write NSF checks. How about signing up for EFT instead?! Contact the Michigan Liquor Control Commission Finance Division for more information, 517-322-1382.
