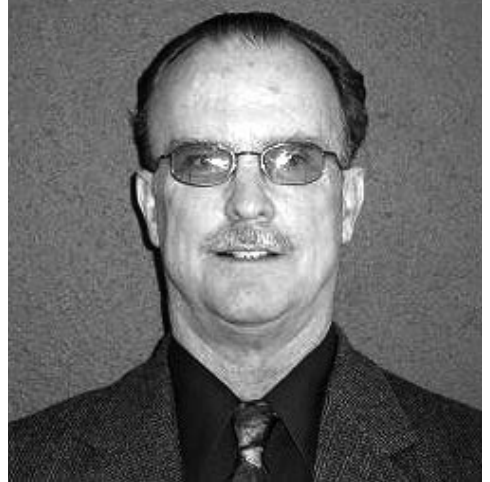
This course has been approved for residential builders pre-licensure safety training requirements.
